



ONE-STOP VOTING BUFFER ZONE NOVEMBER 2, 2021 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

The following is a list of Union County One-Stop Voting locations and a description of each buffer zone concerning electioneering. As designated by §163A-1134, no person or group of persons shall hinder access, harass others, distribute campaign literature, place political advertising, solicit votes, or otherwise engage in election-related activity in the voting place or in a buffer zone which shall be prescribed by the county board of elections around the voting place. In determining the dimensions of that buffer zone for each voting place, the county board of elections shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall it set the limit at more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet.

- Union County Public Library (Griffin Room), 316 East Windsor St., Monroe NC 28112
-- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
