ONE-STOP VOTING BUFFER ZONES NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

The following is a list of Union County One-Stop Voting locations and a description of each buffer zone concerning electioneering. As designated by §163-166.4.(A), no person or group of persons shall hinder access, harass others, distribute campaign literature, place political advertising, solicit votes, or otherwise engage in election-related activity in the voting place or in a buffer zone which shall be prescribed by the county board of elections around the voting place. In determining the dimensions of that buffer zone for each voting place, the county board of elections shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall it set the limit at more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet.

- Monroe High School, 1 High School Drive, Monroe NC 28112 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Mineral Springs VFD, 5804 Waxhaw Hwy., Monroe NC 28112 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Wingate Community Center, 315 W. Elm St., Wingate, NC 28174 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Hemby Bridge VFD, 6628 Mill Grove Rd., Indian Trail, NC 28079 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Stallings VFD, 4616 Old Monroe Rd., Indian Trail, NC 28079 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Rea View Elementary School, 320 Reid Dairy Rd., Waxhaw, NC 28173 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Wesley Chapel VFD, 315 Waxhaw-Indian Trail Rd., Waxhaw, NC 28173 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Marvin Ridge High School, 2825 Crane Rd., Waxhaw, NC 28173 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No electioneering beyond this point". Use 2 inch yellow tape to define Buffer Zone.
